Nonetheless, Plaintiff's counsel proceeded to file it with the court without taking the appropriate measures to preserve confidentiality as required by this Court's Amended First Stipulation and Order of Confidentiality filed on February 11, 2010. Reserving all rights, we respectfully request that the Court direct that the motion, including the transcript of Brother Michael Dimond be placed under seal by Clerk of the Court.
